<sup>\*</sup> Please submit cheques for Sept-April dated for the first of each month. Paypal & Credit will require an additional 3% fee. Monthly payments are subject to a surcharge. An administration fee of \$75 will be charged for canceling registration. Siblings will receive a 10% discount. Discount is applied to the younger sibling/s.

<sup>\*\*</sup> Please post-date a cheque for June 1, 2024. It will not be cashed but held and returned to you when the uniform (dry-cleaned & in good condition) and music are returned. If you prefer, you can pay the \$200 in Sept by etransfer or cash and the deposit will be refunded to you in June.

## Hello CJC families! :)

- Parking is restricted on the street directly beside and in front of the church, but it is fine to park along the side of the Crescent Heights High School which is kitty-corner to the church. There is also a parking lot behind the church which can be accessed from the alley. Please do not park directly across the street from the front door of the church as it is a private residence and we strive to maintain good relations with the neighbors in the community! As well, we encourage everyone to cross at the corner rather than jaywalking as the street can be busy and some drivers go very guickly.
- The front door of the church will routinely be the entrance for your child for each class, and I will be at the door to greet them. You are welcome to see them in the front door and leave the building for the 90 minute rehearsal or you can wait in the building. We do need to keep the noise level down as it can carry into the choir rehearsals, so I may remind people of that from time to time.
- On wet or snowy days, CJC children will be asked to remove their boots at the front door. They can be in sock feet for the rehearsal or you can send a pair of indoor shoes with them.
